

Christmas Season

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of Our Lord, and on this Monday, the Christmas Season will conclude with the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord.

The Christmas Season, which is the annual feast commemorating the event of the Birth of Jesus Christ and those events following his birth. The season itself started on December 25th with the Nativity of Our Lord, and then was followed by our celebrations of the Feast of the Holy Family (which was held on Dec. 30/31) Followed by the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God on January 1st.

The Solemnity of the Epiphany of Our Lord commemorates the visit of the Magi from the East, who travelled from what is believed to be modern-day Iraq to Bethlehem, a journey by camel that would have taken about 12 days. This Solemnity is very important from the point of view of all Christians, as the visit of the Magi, who were foreigners as well as non-Jews, manifests the reality that God's offer of salvation in the newborn Prince of Peace is meant for all peoples of the world.

The season concludes with the celebration of the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. While this event would have taken place when Jesus was about 30 years old, it marks the end of the Christmas season, as Jesus' baptism is seen as the final step before he begins his ministry.

On behalf of all the staff of Nativity of Our Lord, I want to thank all of you for your participation in this Sacred Season, and I wish all of you the best for 2018.
