REFLECTIONS ON PALM SUNDAY & HOLY THURSDAY

Palm Sunday: Today we celebrate the triumphal entry of Jesus Christ into Jerusalem, the week before His death and resurrection. Palm Sunday, properly referred to as "Passion Sunday", marks the beginning of Holy Week, which concludes on Easter Sunday.

The Bible reveals that when Jesus entered Jerusalem, the crowds greeted Him with waving palm branches, and by covering His path with palm branches. Immediately following this great time of celebration in the Ministry of Jesus, He begins His journey to the cross.

The Holy Thursday Liturgy marks the end of Lent and the beginning of the sacred "Triduum" ("three days") of Holy Week, which culminates in the Easter Vigil, and concludes at Vespers on the evening of Easter day. The Mass begins in the evening, because Passover began at it commemorates Our Lord's sundown; institution of the Holy Eucharist at the last Supper. It also shows both the worth God ascribes to the humility of service, and the need for cleansing with water (a symbol of baptism) in the Mandatum, washing, commemorating Jesus' washing the feet of His apostles, as well as in the priest's stripping of the altar. Cleansing, in fact, gave this day of Holy Week the name Maundy Thursday.

The action of the Church on this night also witnesses to the Church's esteem for Christ's Body present in the consecrated Host in the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, carried in solemn procession to the Altar of Repose.

Following the mass, there is an Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament by the people until midnight, just as the disciples stayed with Our Lord during His agony in the Garden of Gethsemane on the Mount of Olives before his betrayal by Judas Iscariot.


