Isaiah 6: 1-2a, 3-8 God's dramatic call to Isaiah.

7 - 2

1 Corinthians 15: 1-11 Paul was called as the least of the apostles.

Luke 5: 1-11 Jesus calls disciples from among fishermen.

Today's readings attest to the fact that God's call list is littered with seemingly unworthy people.
