Family of Faith Campaign update

When our parish undertook the Family of Faith campaign back in 2015 we had to outline how we would spend the parish's share of the campaign monies that were raised.

These projects included:

- 1) updating the lighting inside the parish hall and the surrounding corridors;
- 2) updating the parish hall kitchen;
- and 3) the installation of an electronic sign by the Rathburn Rd. entrance.

Having done so, we anticipate, with your continued pledge commitments being fulfilled, that we will still have a considerable amount of money (over \$200,000) to spend from the parish's proceeds of the Campaign.

Following the Guidelines of the Family of Faith Campaign – Updated Policies and Procedures dated June 30, 2016, I recently met both with our parish's Finance and Property Council and our Pastoral Council (as per point 3 of the Updated Policies) to consider some further projects.

In our discussions both Councils felt that we should spend the remaining money on

- 1) Replacing the carpet in the sanctuary of the church:
- 2) Do a refurbishment of the exterior façade of the church above the Rathburn Rd. entrance; and
- 3) Replace the framing surrounding the large World Youth Day 2002 stained glass window on the east side of the sanctuary.

We have received formal approval for these next 3 projects from Bishop John Boissonneau, the Western Region Auxiliary Bishop of Toronto, and Mr. Jim Milway, the Temporal Chancellor for the Archdiocese of Toronto, as is required, and we hope to begin the first project this fall, and hopefully, some, if not all of the second project later this summer.

I will have further updates for you for the first bulletin after the summer break, the weekend of August 31st/September 1st.
