Thomas Cardinal Collins, the Archbishop of Toronto, has decreed that the Feast of St. Michael the Archangel, which is this Sunday, Sept. 29th, will be recognized as a solemnity in all parishes and missions of the Archdiocese of Toronto, including Nativity of Our Lord Parish.

Our readings for the Saturday 5:00 pm mass and the Sunday 9:00 am and 11:30 am mass this weekend are as follows;

- **1st Reading: Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14**
- **Psalm 138**
- **2nd Reading: Revelation 12: 7-12a**
- **Gospel: John 1:47-51**

This of course means that the readings found in our Living with Christ missals for this Sunday September 29th (which would have been the 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time) are not used.
