

TWENTY NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

World Mission Sunday

7 - 2

Exodus 17:8-13 As long as Moses prayed, the Israelites were victorious.

2 Timothy 3:14-4:2 Be persistent, whether convenient or inconvenient.

Luke 18:1-8 Pray always without becoming weary.

The first reading presents Moses as a leader in need of support from Aaron and Hur in order to keep his hands raised in prayer to assure a victory for Israel – an image that reminds us that we do not stand alone in our life of faith but that we need others to support us. In a similar way, missionaries depend on support from home to continue their work of evangelization. In the Gospel, Jesus asks, 'But when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?' That thought should be reason enough for us today to share the Gospel with others in our own time. We are challenged with sharing our faith, especially with the next generation, just as it was shared to us by those who have gone before us.
