Lent originated as a season to prepare for Baptism. Historians tell us that from about the fifth century the practice of admitting serious sinners to a public order of penitents in Lent also developed. During the first days of the Lenten season, these people would begin their penance with outward signs, such as taking on a hair shirt, and they would be reconciled on Holy Thursday. When the practice of public penance waned, another grew up in its place. From about the eleventh century, Lent became a season of penance for the faithful, who were sprinkled with ashes as a sign of their penitential spirit.

Today, Catholics and other Christians continue to cultivate a spirit of penitence during Lent in preparation for Easter. The sign of the cross, made with blessed ashes on the foreheads of the faithful, is a reminder that purification is arrived at by way of the cross. Death to self is the path-way to new life. The ritual of receiving ashes on this day has a mysterious power. It resonates with something deep in the human soul. Even when individuals have abandoned much of the practice of the Catholic faith, they will present themselves for this rite. The ashes of this day speak of mortality and sin, which humble us all before the majesty of God.

Day of Obligatory Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday is one of the two universal days of obligatory fasting. It allows for the consumption of one meal, and two smaller meals during the day to keep up strength. These two small portions should add up to less than a full meal together. Children, elderly and the sick are not bound by fasting regulations.

It is also a day of obligatory abstinence from meat. This practice began when meat was a luxury. Those who keep to the spirit of abstinence, as well as its letter, will eat simply and avoid all <u>expensive</u> foods on this day.

A Christian brings peace to others. Not only peace, but also Love, Kindness, Faithfulness and Joy.
