1 Samuel 16:1, 6-7, 10-13 God sees into our hearts.

Ephesians 5:8-14 Live as children of light.

John 9:1-41 The healing of the man born blind.

The healing of the young man born blind – a story of how sight is given back to a young man. Sight reveals to us the beauty of God's creation. 
