Saturdays: 4:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. OR anytime by appointment.


SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

TWENTY SEVENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

Isaiah 5:1-7 God's judgment on the vineyard, Israel.

Philippians 4:6-9 How to know true peace. *Matthew 21:33-43* The kingdom of God is for people who will produce its fruit.

In today's Gospel, we hear that the kingdom of God is not ours by right, but a gift, and we must produce the fruit of God's kingdom. What is that fruit? In the second reading, St. Paul is at his most poetic as he describes the fruit of the Christian life. The parable of the vineyard "reminds disciples that each of us is like a tenant farmer or a steward who has been entrusted with the upkeep of God's vineyard, i.e., with the care of this earth and one another. One day, each of us will be asked to render an account of ourselves and our responsibility for all that God has given us."
