FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Jeremiah 31:31-34 God will write the divine law upon our hearts.

Hebrew 5:7-9 Jesus prayed to be saved from death, but was obedient.

John 12:20-33 Only if a grain of wheat dies does it produce fruit.

Our readings today increase our awareness of the suffering and death of the Lord which will be heightened in next week's reading of the Passion of the Lord. It is the time when we must ask ourselves, what I have I done in the spirit of Lent? If I had made any Lenten promises, have I kept them? If I am not fasting more or praying more or giving more to the poor - I can start today. In the readings today, we will hear about the end of life. All things come to an end. The time to begin living as we want to live is now. It is now that we live the lives that prepare us for eternal life with Jesus. We remember with gratitude the struggle of Jesus, who willingly gave Himself to be lifted up on the cross and, in glory - draws all peoples to Himself and to God.
