

Acts 9:26-31, Living in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit it (the Church) increased in numbers.

1 John 3:18-24 Little children, let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action.

John 15: 4,5 Whoever abides in me and I in them bears much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing.

Today we hear of the early Christian communities as they multiplied and grew. Spreading the Gospel was a risky thing, and they were motivated and fed by their memories of Jesus' powerful words.
