Beginning on Monday, July 12th, work will be done to restore and refurbish the exterior of the church building that faces Rathburn Rd. It is anticipated that this work will be completed by the end of August. This project will be paid for through your generous donations to the Family of Faith campaign that was held in 2015-19.

Increase in Attendance Capacity

With the Province entering Step 2 on June 30th, places of worship are being allowed up to a maximum of 25% capacity, while maintaining proper social distancing. In light of this, our attendance capacity at Nativity has been raised to 220 persons per mass. It is anticipated that this will remain so until the pandemic restrictions are fully lifted. However, the Funeral Authority of Ontario has set the maximum capacity allowed for funeral masses to be 75 persons.
