2024 Parish Tax Receipts

2024 Parish Tax Receipts for donations received at the parish are being processed, and assuming Canada Post is on time, parishioners will receive them in the mail on or before Monday February 17th.

Tax receipts for donations using credit cards on the parish website are issued by the Archdiocese and parishioners should also receive them by February 17th.

Canada Revenue Agency Message

The Canada Revenue Agency has confirmed that it has extended the deadline for making charitable donations eligible to be claimed on a donor's 2024 income tax return until February 28, 2025. The government introduced this extension to help charities that were negatively impacted by the Canada Post disruption. Charities are not required to issue tax receipts specific to this two-month period.

If you wish to claim your January and February, 2025 donations on your 2024 income tax receipt:
